

RESOLUTION NO. 2349

WHEREAS, Section 9.04.040 of the Albany Municipal Code requires plumbing fixtures to be connected to a public sewer when available; and

WHEREAS, the City Council is authorized to waive the requirement for a period not to exceed one year by the issuance of a nonconnection permit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that it be the policy of the Albany City Council to approve applications for a nonconnection permit in the case of financial hardship only when all of the following conditions exist:

1. The Linn County Health Department determines that no health hazard will be continued or created.
2. The applicants family income for the last year is not more than 80% of the median family income for Linn County.
3. The applicant agrees to connect to the public sewer within one year.
4. The applicant agrees to connect to the sewer immediately if the private sewage disposal system fails to adequately treat sewage or a health hazard is created.
5. The permit is revocable by the City on thirty (30) days' written notice to the property owner if it is determined that a health hazard exists as a result of the failure to connect the plumbing fixtures to the public sewer.
